Additional information

Shoes	<p>For health and safety reasons all children are required to wear sturdy black shoes lace up or with a strap. No trainers, sandals or ballet pump style shoes. Trainers must only be worn during PE and sporting activities.</p> <p>During inclement weather, boots and wellingtons may be worn into school but children will be asked to change into their school shoes during school hours.</p>
Jewellery	<p>Children may wear a small plain watch and, in pierced ears, small stud earrings that they need to be able to take out for PE and. No other jewellery is permitted.</p>
Bags for school day	<p>All children should have a book bag with school logo. This will be used for taking books, reading log, homework and letters to and from school. They are stored in drawers in the classroom therefore due to this limited storage we are unable to allow larger bags and rucksacks into school.</p> <p>PE kit should be carried to school in the royal blue gym bag with school logo. This is brought into school on Monday and will be taken home on Friday.</p> <p>Packed lunches are best carried in an insulated bag of the children's own choice.</p>

Coat	Children are required wear a dark blue or black coat to school suitable for the weather. If walking to and from school, darker mornings and evenings, parents/guardians might like to consider coats that contain some reflective materials. A navy weatherproof fleece with the school logo is available online but this is not compulsory.
Sunhats	During the hotter weather your child will need a plain navy or royal blue hat to wear during outdoor play and activities
Hair	We ask that hair should be in a neat hairstyle appropriate for school activities and there is no extreme hairstyles, colouring, and excessive use of hair gel or additional hairpieces. All long hair needs to be tied back. Hair accessories to be of a simple style and colour to match uniform or hair.
Makeup and Nail Varnish	Children are asked not wear makeup to school and to remove nail varnish.
